A ball lying in all areas marked GUR must be lifted and dropped without penalty at nearest point of relief, not nearer the hole being played. On the putting green, a ball that comes to rest in or on an aeration hole may be placed at the nearest spot, not nearer

Where a ball lies on the side of the bank before the ditch to the right of the 4th fairway, or where the banking interferes with the player's stance, the ball may be dropped, without penalty, within one club-length from the base of the bank

If a ball lies with the staked/fenced off area at the base and to the right of the valley feature on the 17th fairway defined as GUR, or interferes with a players stance or swing, play is prohibited and a ball must be dropped without penalty, within one club-length of the nearest point of relief, not nearer the hole or in the designated drop zone.
